- February 11th **Registration Deadline: Random Public Drawing During Pirate Advisory Committee (PAC)** - 5:00 - 5:30pm @ Zoom Link. In the event that there are more registration applications than openings, a random public drawing will be held at our PAC meeting on February 11th.

## Details

Families will be notified of the results by telephone or mail within 5 business days. After receiving notification for admission, parents will have 3 business days to finalize their decision. The following stipulations will apply:

- Up until July 31st, parents will have 3 days to finalize their decision after being notified.
- After August 1st parents will have 24 hours to exercise their enrollment option.
- **Waiting lists will not carry over from year to year.**

Families not receiving a placement will be put on a waiting list in the order determined by the random public drawing. The following admission preference apply to students with the following conditions prior to the random public drawing:

- Students whose parents are employed full-time at Northern Humboldt Union High School District.
- Students whose parents are employed part-time at Northern Humboldt Union High School District.
- Siblings of students currently attending the school.
- Siblings of Six Rivers Alumni

Registration materials received after February 11th will be numbered and placed at the bottom of the waiting list.
